

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS ADJACENT TO TRAVIS PARK IN CITY COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 FROM SEPTEMBER 19, 2003 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 22, 2003 IN CONNECTION WITH THE 2003 20<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL JAZZ'SALIVE FESTIVAL IN TRAVIS PARK AS REQUESTED BY THE SAN ANTONIO PARKS FOUNDATION.

**WHEREAS**, The San Antonio Parks Foundation is holding its 2003 Jazz'SAlive Festival in Travis Park from September 19, 2003 through September 22, 2003 and in connection with said event has requested the temporary closure of certain streets adjacent to Travis Park to vehicular traffic to accommodate said event; and

**WHEREAS**, the request for this temporary closure of these streets has been evaluated and it has been found that no adverse traffic problems would result, and that the request should be granted in accordance with the City's usual practice and procedure for temporary street closures; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**Section 1.** The temporary closure of the following streets in connection with the 2003 Jazz'SAlive Festival, scheduled for September 19, 2003 through September 22, 2003 is hereby approved for the dates and times indicated:

1. Two lanes of Pecan Street between Navarro Street and Jefferson Street - on Friday, September 19, 2003 from 9:00 AM until 6:30 PM.
2. All lanes of Pecan Street between Navarro and Jefferson Street - from Saturday, September 20, 2003 at 6:30 AM until Monday, September 22, 2003 at 6:00 AM.
3. All lanes of Navarro Street between Travis and Pecan - from Friday, September 19, 2003 at 6:30 PM until Monday, September 22, 2003 at 6:00 AM.
4. All lanes of Jefferson Street between Martin and Travis – from Saturday, September 20, 2003 at 6:30 AM until Monday, September 22, 2003 at 6:00 AM. (Jefferson Street reopens on Sunday, September 22, 2003 from 6:00 AM until 12:00 Noon to allow pedestrian and vehicular access for local church activities.)

**Section 2.** The streets named herein may be utilized by the San Antonio Parks Foundation in connection with its planned 2003 Jazz' SAlive Festival.

**Section 3.** Authorized emergency vehicles operated by the San Antonio Police and/or Fire Departments are hereby specifically exempted from the above stated closure restrictions.

**Section 4.** Parking meters around Travis Park will be restricted from use on Friday, September 19, 2003 to facilitate the street closure and set up for the event.

**Section 5.** By making this special use of a public right-of-way, the San Antonio Parks Foundation agrees to assume all risks inherent in this undertaking, and will indemnify and hold harmless the City from any and all costs, liability or damages arising from or growing out of this usage. The San Antonio Parks Foundation must execute a standard City Street Closure Agreement to evidence its acceptance of the terms and conditions contained in this ordinance.

**Section 6.** This ordinance shall be effective on the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.


