

AN ORDINANCE **98092**

ACCEPTING THE LOW QUALIFITED BIDS FROM CASCO INDUSTRIES, INC., ITEMS 1, 5 AND 6; MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY SERVICES, ITEMS 3 AND 4; ARMORED TEXTILES, INC. ITEM 7; AND FERRARA FIRE APPARATUS, ITEMS 8 AND 9 TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH FIRE HOSES FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$66,252.60.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with fire hoses which will be utilized in routine structural and brush firefighting; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Armored Textiles, Inc., items 1 and 3 failed to meet the City specifications; and

WHEREAS, Casco Industries, Inc., items 1, 5 and 6; Municipal Emergency Services, items 3 and 4; Armored Textiles, Inc. item 7; and Ferrara Fire Apparatus, items 8 and 9 were the low qualified bidders for a total contract cost of \$66,252.60; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low, qualified bids of Casco Industries, Inc., items 1, 5 and 6; Municipal Emergency Services, items 3 and 4; Armored Textiles, Inc. item 7; and Ferrara Fire Apparatus, items 8 and 9 to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with fire hoses for a total amount of \$66,252.60 are hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bids and bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the low bid of Armored Textiles, Inc. items 1 and 3 failed to meet the City's specifications.

SECTION 3. Funds will be encumbered in Fund 11 (General Fund) in Index Code 275834 entitled Fire Hoses and Accessories when a purchase order is issued and made payable to Casco Industries Inc.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.


