

AN ORDINANCE      **9 8 1 7 1**

**ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF VARIOUS COMPANIES TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WITH THE FOLLOWING ITEMS AND SERVICES ON AN ANNUAL CONTRACT BASIS FOR FY 2003-2004 FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$1,320,114.00: PAGERS, TEMPERATURE MANAGEMENT CONTROL SYSTEM MAINTENANCE AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; E-MAIL SCAN EQUIPMENT; KVS SOFTWARE & SUPPORT; FIBRE CHANNEL SWITCH EQUIPMENT; ESRI MAPPING APPLICATION SERVICES; MATERIALS & LABOR TO MAINTAIN HEATING & AIR CONDITIONING SYSTEMS AT FIRE STATIONS; FIRE INTERCOM SYSTEMS; AUTO & LIGHT TRUCK DRUMS & BRAKE PADS; AND SAFETY SUPPLIES.**

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**WHEREAS**, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

**WHEREAS**, this group of contracts represents a portion of approximately two hundred and fifty (250) annual contracts that will be brought before City Council throughout the remainder of the fiscal year; and

**WHEREAS**, these bids are from various companies to furnish the City with pagers, temperature management control system maintenance at San Antonio International Airport, e-mail scan equipment, KVS software & support, fibre channel switch equipment, ESRI mapping application services, materials & labor to maintain heating & air conditioning systems at fire stations, fire intercom systems, auto & light truck drums & brake pads, and safety supplies; and

**WHEREAS**, Section I of the attachment entitled "Single Source Bids" consists of one (1) single source of supply contract; and

**WHEREAS**, the bids in Section II entitled "Competitive Low Bids" consist of eight (8) competitive bids in which awards are recommended to the lowest bidders; and

**WHEREAS**, the "Low Qualified Bids", as set out in Section III of the attachment, consist of seven (7) contracts in which award is recommended to bidders other than the lowest bidders because the low bids failed to meet the City's specifications and/or requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, it is estimated that approximately \$20,000,000.00 will be spent on annual contracts during the 2003-2004 fiscal year and such expenditures will be in accordance with the 2003-2004 budget to be approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The bids of various companies to furnish the City with pagers, temperature management control system maintenance at San Antonio International Airport, e-mail scan equipment, KVS software & support, fibre channel switch equipment, ESRI mapping application services, materials & labor to maintain heating & air conditioning systems at fire stations, fire intercom systems, auto & light truck

drums & brake pads, and safety supplies on an annual contract basis, as shown on the attached bid tabulation sheets incorporated herein, are hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bids and bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

**SECTION 2.** This ordinance contains sixteen (16) contract awards for a total estimated annual cost of \$1,320,114.00, of which \$78,894.00 (3 awards) or approximately 4.41% are being awarded to WBEs. Copies of all bid packets are available for review in the Purchasing Department of the City of San Antonio and a list of the successful bidders is available for review in the City Clerk's Office.

**SECTION 3.** Funding will not be expended by this ordinance. The approval of the contracts specified in this ordinance is expressly contingent upon appropriation of funds.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.


