

AN ORDINANCE **98153**

ACCEPTING THE LOW QUALIFIED BIDS THAT WERE SUBMITTED BY GLOBE ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC. (WBE), ITEMS 1, 3, 4, 5; AND GRAYBAR ELECTRIC COMPANY, INC., ITEM 2 TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO ALAMODOME WITH STEP LIGHTING FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$147,416.50.

WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Alamodome with step lighting which will be utilized to replace non-functional lighting parts and will provide new lighting in areas that are poorly illuminated; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Multi-Source Corp. failed to meet City specifications; and

WHEREAS, Globe Electric Company, Inc. (WBE), items 1, 3, 4, 5 and Graybar Electric Company, Inc., item 2, were the low qualified bidders for a total amount of \$147,416.50; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low, qualified bids of Globe Electric Company, Inc. (WBE), items 1, 3, 4, 5 and Graybar Electric Company, Inc., item 2, to provide the City of San Antonio Alamodome with step lighting for a total amount of \$147,416.50 are hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bids and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the low bid of Multi-Source Corp. failed to meet City's specifications.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$147,416.50 is appropriated in Fund 29-006001 (Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund) in Index Code 505511 entitled "Maintenance and Repairs – Buildings and Improvements", and funds in the amount of \$147,416.50 will be encumbered when a purchase order is issued and made payable to Globe Electronic, Inc and Graybar for step lighting.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by

the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.


