

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF \$650.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 3 CONTINGENCY ACCOUNT FUND, PAYABLE TO POSITIVE BEGINNINGS, INC., TO BE USED TO PURCHASE MATERIALS FOR ITS CHILDCARE AND ADULT CARE PROGRAM; AS REQUESTED BY ANTONIETTE "TONI" MOORHOUSE.

WHEREAS, Councilwoman Antoniette "Toni" Moorhouse, District 3, has requested Council concurrence for the expenditure of \$650.00 from the District 3 Contingency Account Fund to assist Positive Beginnings, Inc. in purchasing materials for its childcare and adult care program; and

WHEREAS, Positive Beginnings, Inc. promotes the public purpose of advancing social and economic stability; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to authorize the expenditure requested by Councilwoman Antoniette "Toni" Moorhouse ; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The request of Councilwoman Antoniette "Toni" Moorhouse, District 3, for reimbursement from the District 3 Contingency Account Fund in the amount of \$650.00 to Positive Beginnings to be used to purchase materials for its childcare and adult care program is hereby approved and authorized. A copy of Councilwoman Antoniette "Toni" Moorhouse's request is set out in **Attachment I**.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to execute an agreement with Positive Beginnings, Inc. in the amount of \$650.00. A copy of the "Agreement to Use Funds of the City of San Antonio," in substantially final form, is attached hereto as **Attachment II**.

SECTION 3. The amount of \$650.00 is authorized to be encumbered for payment in the District 3 Contingency Account, Index Code 603506 entitled "District 3 Contingency Fund" and is made payable to Positive Beginnings, Inc. to purchase materials for its childcare and adult care programs.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective on the tenth day after the passage hereof.


