

AN ORDINANCE **98603**

**AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$80,000.00 TO THE OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION, WHICH, IF AWARDED, WILL BE USED TO FUND THE NINTH YEAR OF THE ADMINISTRATION AND COORDINATION EFFORTS OF THE CRISIS ASSISTANCE TEAM ADMINISTRATION OF THE VICTIMS ADVOCACY SECTION; AND AUTHORIZING AN IN-KIND MATCH OF \$19,260.00 AND A GENERAL FUND MATCH OF \$7,401.00.**

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Police Department has established Crisis Assistance Teams to provide crisis intervention for battered women and their children; and

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, has grant funds available in the amount of \$80,000.00 to fund the ninth year of the administrative and coordination efforts of the Crisis Assistance Team Administration of the Victims Advocacy Section; and

**WHEREAS**, a trained corps of community volunteers will provide crisis intervention for battered women and their children; and

**WHEREAS**, two civilian positions, a Program Coordinator and an Assistant Program Coordinator, will continue to be funded through this grant to provide program support; and

**WHEREAS**, Assistant City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, is the city official designated to be authorized grant official; and

**WHEREAS**, in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, the City of San Antonio will return all funds to the Criminal Justice Division in full; and

**WHEREAS**, an award of these grant funds will require an in-kind match of \$19,260.00 which consists of volunteer hours and a general fund cash match of \$7,401.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Assistant City Manager, Christopher J. Brady, is hereby authorized to submit a grant application to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division, in the amount of \$80,000.00 for funds for the ninth year of the administrative and coordination efforts of the Crisis Assistance Team Administration of the Victims Advocacy Section. Mr. Brady is hereby designated as the authorized grant official.

**SECTION 2.** An award of these grant funds would require an in-kind matching contribution through volunteer hours in the amount of \$19,260.00 and a general fund cash match of \$7,401.00, which are hereby authorized in connection with the submission of the grant application.

**SECTION 3.** In the event of loss or misuse of Criminal Justice Division funds, the City of San Antonio will return all funds to the Criminal Justice Division.

**SECTION 4.** Funding will be accomplished by way of a subsequent Ordinance should the grant funds be awarded.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
