

AN ORDINANCE **98360**

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR PALO ALTO COLLEGE IN CONNECTION WITH THE TRI-PALO ALTO SPONSORED BY THE RUN AWAY STORE, WHICH WILL BE HELD ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 2003 FROM 7:00 A.M. UNTIL 10:30 A.M.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the parade permit requested by the Palo Alto College to temporary close a portion of certain streets near Palo Alto College is contingent upon the availability of funds from the sponsor, Run Away Store and receipt by the City of payment for any permits or fees due to the City to hold the "Tri-Palo Alto" event on Sunday, November 16, 2003 from 7:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. In order to hold the "Tri-Palo Alto" event on Sunday, November 16, 2003 from 7:00 a.m. until 10:30 a.m., the temporary closure of portions of certain streets listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

Assembly Area: The run/walk will assemble and disband at Palo Alto College.

Route: Parade route will begin at Palo Alto College
EXIT PALO ALTO COLLEGE.
WEST ON SE LOOP 410 ACCESS TO PALO ALTO ROAD.
TAKE TURNAROUND FROM PALO ALTO ROAD TO SE LOOP 410 EAST BOUND ACCESS ROAD.
CROSS ZARZAMORA STAY ON EAST BOUND ACCESS ROAD TO NEXT TURNAROUND.
TAKE TURNAROUND FROM EAST BOUND ACCESS ROAD TO WEST BOUND SE LOOP 410 ON ACCESS ROAD.
CROSS ZARZAMORA FROM WEST BOUND SE LOOP 410 ACCESS ROAD AND PROCEED TO THE TURNAROUND AT PALO ALTO ROAD
REPEAT COURSE TWICE.
WHEN RETURNING FROM THE TURNAROUND AT PALO ALTO ROAD ENTER PALO ALTO COLLEGE TO DISBAND.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. Run Away Store shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,
- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 5. Run Away Store shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on the 9th day of November 2003.
