

AN ORDINANCE

**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98284, PASSED AND APPROVED ON OCTOBER 2, 2003, IN ORDER TO MODIFY THE COMPOSITION OF THE CITIZENS COMMISSION ON CITY/COUNTY SERVICE INTEGRATION BY REFLECTING REVEREND TERRANCE HAYS AS ONE OF THE CITY'S APPOINTEES; CORRECTING THE SPELLING OF THE LAST NAME OF MS. REBECCA CEDILLO; AND DENOTING THE APPOINTMENT OF MS. SHEILA MCNEIL, AS A BEXAR COUNTY APPOINTEE.**

**WHEREAS**, by the passage of Ordinance No. 98284, approved by the City Council on October 2, 2003, ten individuals were appointed to represent the City on the joint Citizens Commission on City/County Service Integration (the "Commission"); and

**WHEREAS**, through Ordinance No. 98284, the City Council intended that Reverend Terrance Hays be appointed as a City representative on the Commission and Ms. Sheila McNeil serve as a Bexar County representative on the Commission; and


**WHEREAS**, furthermore City Council intended to appoint Ms. Rebecca Cedillo, not Ms. Rebecca Castillo; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**


**SECTION 1.** The amendment to Ordinance No. 98284 modifying the composition of the Citizens Commission on City/County Service Integration by reflecting Reverend Terrance Hays as one of the City's appointees, correcting the spelling of the last name of Ms. Rebecca Cedillo, and denoting the appointment of Ms. Sheila McNeil as a Bexar County appointee is hereby authorized and approved.
