

AN ORDINANCE **9 8 5 3 6**

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT AWARD IN THE AMOUNT OF \$356,700.00 FROM THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (TDH) TO SUPPORT THE ONGOING TUBERCULOSIS PREVENTION AND CONTROL PROGRAM OF THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT FOR THE PERIOD JANUARY 1, 2004 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2004; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF GRANT CONTRACT 7460020708 2005 WITH TDH; ESTABLISHING A FUND FOR THE PUBLIC HEALTH STATE SUPPORT PROJECT 2004/2005 – FEDERAL ACCOUNT; ADOPTING THE PROGRAM BUDGET; APPROVING THE PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT; AND AUTHORIZING PAYMENTS FOR CONTRACTUAL SERVICES.

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WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Health (TDH) provides annual financial assistance to the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) to supplement the delivery of various comprehensive public health services to protect the health of all residents within the jurisdiction of the District; and

WHEREAS, TDH has offered a contract to the SAMHD which will provide cash assistance to the SAMHD for the Public Health State Support Project 2004/2005 for the period beginning January 1, 2004; and

WHEREAS, TDH has initially offered \$356,700.00 to the SAMHD in order to support the ongoing Tuberculosis Prevention and Control Program of the SAMHD during the period January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to authorize the acceptance of the award and the execution of TDH Grant Contract 7460020708 2005, establish a fund for the Public Health State Support Project 2004/2005 – Federal Account, adopt the program budget, approve the personnel complement, and authorize payments for contractual services; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept a grant award in the amount of \$356,700.00 from the Texas Department of Health, which will provide \$356,700.00 in support for the Tuberculosis Prevention and Control Program of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) for the period January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004. The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to execute Grant Contract 7460020708 2005, Attachment 01, with the Texas Department of Health (TDH). A copy of Grant Contract 7460020708 2005 is set out in Attachment II and incorporated herein for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The account entitled "Public Health State Support Project 2004/2005 - Federal", Fund No. 26-016066 is designated for use in the accounting of the Tuberculosis (TB) Prevention and Control Program. This fund is authorized for use in accordance with Grant Contract 7460020708 2005.

SECTION 3. The sum of \$376,700.00 is hereby appropriated in the above-designated fund and the budget set out in Attachment I is approved and adopted for entry on the City books.

SECTION 4. Payments in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$25,500.00 are authorized for the services of licensed contract physicians seeing patients suspected of having tuberculosis, the services of licensed contract x-ray technicians, and x-ray interpretation services at the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District Tuberculosis Clinic for the period January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004. These payments will be made from Fund 26-016066, Activity 36-07-14, Index Code 784025 on a fee-for-service basis.

SECTION 5. Consistent with the lease approved by Ordinance 96290 on September 5, 2002, rent payments in an aggregate amount not to exceed \$20,000.00 are authorized for the building at 814 McCullough in connection with the SAMHD's TB Prevention and Control Program for the period January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004. These payments will be made from Fund 26-016066, Activity 36-07-14, Index Code 783464.

SECTION 6. The fourteen (14) personnel positions set out in Attachment I and incorporated herein are authorized for the activity shown thereon.

SECTION 7. Co-payments obtained from patients receiving services through the TB Clinic will be deposited in Fund No. 26-016066, Revenue Index Code 081943.

SECTION 8. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 9. Should the grant awarded be in an amount other than that budgeted for, or should the grant contain terms and conditions different than those currently existing, acceptance of the grant, budget and corresponding personnel complement will be subject to subsequent City Council ordinance.

SECTION 10. This ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10th) day after passage hereof.
