**AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 88485, PASSED AND APPROVED ON SEPTEMBER 17, 1998, BY REALLOCATING \$16,000.00 FROM THE FY 1999 ONE-TIME PROJECT FUND DESIGNATED TO THE DISTRICT 5 SPEED TRAILER PROJECT AND \$4,000.00 FROM THE SCHOOL FLASHER PROJECT AND ALLOCATING \$20,000.00 TO THE DISTRICT 5 ADVOCATES SOCIAL SERVICES ONE-TIME PROJECT; AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 90485, PASSED AND APPROVED ON SEPTEMBER 16, 1999, BY TRANSFERRING \$5,000.00 FROM THE FY 2000 ONE-TIME PROJECT FUND DESIGNATED TO THE DISTRICT 5 COMPUTER REVITALIZATION PROJECT, \$5,000.00 FROM THE FY 2003 COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND AND \$5,000.00 FROM THE FY 2003 COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND TO THE SAN ANTONIO ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS FOR REFORM NOW PROJECT; AMENDING ORDINANCE 90485, PASSED AND APPROVED ON SEPTEMBER 16, 1999, BY TRANSFERRING \$10,000.00 FROM FY 2000 ONE-TIME PROJECT FUND DESIGNATED TO THE DISTRICT 5 COMPUTER REVITALIZATION PROJECT AND \$5,000.00 FROM THE FY 2000 COUNCIL DISTRICT 1 HUMAN DEVELOPMENT SERVICES FUND TO THE SAN ANTONIO YOUTH CENTERS PROJECT; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE ADVOCATES SOCIAL SERVICES OF SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS, SAN ANTONIO ASSOCIATION OF COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS FOR REFORM NOW, AND SAN ANTONIO YOUTH CENTERS IN CONNECTION WITH THE EXPENDITURE OF SAID FUNDS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council passed and approved the Fiscal Year (FY) 1999 Budget Ordinance Number 88485, on September 17, 1998 allocating \$32,000.00 in Council District 5 One-Time Projects Fund for two Public Works initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Radle expressed her commitment to re-allocate \$20,000.00 to the Advocates Social Services of San Antonio Texas, a not for profit organization providing food stamp outreach support to low-income individuals; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council passed and approved the Fiscal Year (FY) 2000 Budget Ordinance Number 90485, on September 16, 1999 allocating \$141,500.00 in Council District 5 One-Time Projects Fund for neighborhood revitalization initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Patti Radle expressed her commitment to re-allocate \$5,000.00 from said fund and Councilmember Enrique Barrera expressed his commitment to provide \$5,000.00 from Council District 6 Human Development Services Fund and Councilmember Julian Castro expressed his commitment to provide \$5,000.00 from Council District 7 Human Development Services Fund to San Antonio Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now, a not for profit agency providing Earned Income Tax Credit outreach in Council Districts 5, 6 and 7; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Patti Radle expressed her commitment to re-allocate \$10,000.00 from said fund and Councilmember Roger Flores expressed his commitment to provide \$10,000.00 from Council District 1 Human Development Services Fund to San Antonio Youth Centers to foster the development of inner-city youth; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives is authorized to execute a contract with the Advocates Social Services of San Antonio Texas in the amount of \$20,000.00, San Antonio Association of Community Organizations for Reform Now in the amount of \$15,000.00 and San Antonio Youth Centers in the amount of \$20,000.00 to support various programs described herein. A copy of the contract, in substantially final form, to be used for each of the aforementioned projects, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

**SECTION 2.** The budget in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund) in the following index codes is authorized for reduction by \$55,000.00 as follows:

Funds in the amount of \$15,000.00 are authorized to be appropriated and encumbered in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund) in Index Code 697797 entitled "San Antonio ACORN" and are authorized to be made payable to San Antonio ACORN.




