

AN ORDINANCE **98658**

**ACCEPTING THE LOW, RESPONSIVE BID
SUBMITTED BY DEWINNE EQUIPMENT CO. TO
PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO PUBLIC
WORKS DEPARTMENT WITH ZERO TURN RADIUS
MOWERS FOR A TOTAL OF \$40,950.00.**

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Department with zero turn radius mowers, which will be utilized for maintenance of medians throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, the bids submitted by Moridge Manufacturing, Inc., bid no. 1 and 2 and R&R Tractor & Equipment Ltd. failed to meet the City's specifications; and

WHEREAS, DeWinne Equipment Co. was the low responsive bidder for a total contract cost of \$40,950.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low, responsive bid of DeWinne Equipment Co. to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Department with zero turn radius mowers for a total of \$40,950.00 is hereby accepted. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bid and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the low bids of Moridge Manufacturing, Inc., bid no. 1 and 2 and R&R Tractor & Equipment Ltd. failed to meet the City's specifications.

SECTION 3. Funds in the amount of \$40,950.00 are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund), in Index Code 442004 entitled "Machinery and Equipment - Other" when a purchase order is issued and made payable to DeWinne Equipment Company.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.


