

AN ORDINANCE **98705**

ACCEPTING THE LOW, RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED BY CKS HYDRO SERVICES, INC. TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO AVIATION DEPARTMENT WITH RUBBER AND PAINT DEPOSIT REMOVAL FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$34,900.00.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Aviation Department with rubber and paint deposit removal which will be utilized to remove rubber and paint deposits from runway pavement surfaces at the International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by Rampart Hydro Services LP failed to meet the City specifications; and

WHEREAS, CKS Hydro Services, Inc. was the low responsive bidder for a total contract cost of \$34,900.00; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The low, responsive bid of CKS Hydro Services, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Aviation Department with rubber and paint deposit removal for a total amount of \$34,900.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bid and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. It has been found and declared that the low bid of Rampart Hydro Services LP failed to meet the City's specifications.

SECTION 3. Funds in the amount of \$34,900.00 are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 51-001000 (Aviation Fund), in Index Code 352526 entitled "Maintenance & Repair – Buildings & Improvements" when a purchase order is issued and made payable to CKS Hydro Services Inc.

SECTION 4. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
