

AN ORDINANCE **98760**

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 90485, PASSED AND APPROVED ON SEPTEMBER 16, 1999, BY REALLOCATING \$5,600.00 FROM THE DISTRICT 3 FISCAL YEAR 2000 ONE-TIME PROJECTS FUND DESIGNATED TO THE ACCION FACILITY LANDSCAPING PROJECT TO THE MILITARY PARADE PROJECT; AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF SAID AMOUNT TO THE U.S. MILITARY PARADE ASSOCIATION FOR POLICE SERVICES REQUIRED AT THE VETERANS DAY PARADE IN SAN ANTONIO, TEXAS ON NOVEMBER 8, 2003.

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**WHEREAS**, the City Council passed and approved the Fiscal Year (FY) 2000 Budget Ordinance Number 90485, on September 16, 1999 allocating Council District 3 One-Time Projects Funds for various community initiatives; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Military Veterans Parade Association, a not for profit organization, organized and conducted a military parade on November 8, 2003 to honor and recognize all U.S. military personnel who serve or have served our country; and

**WHEREAS**, the U.S. Military Veterans Parade Association has requested assistance paying for the cost of San Antonio Police services incurred as a result of the parade; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilman Segovia has expressed his commitment to re-allocate \$5,600.00 from the Council District 3 One-Time Projects Fund to support said event; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Ordinance No. 90485, passed and approved on September 16, 1999 is hereby amended by reallocating \$5,600.00 from the District 3 Fiscal Year 2000 One Time Projects Fund designated to the Accion Facility Landscaping Project to the Military Parade Project.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee is authorized to execute a contract with the U.S. Military Veterans Parade Association for the provision of police services in support of its November 8, 2003 Veterans Day Parade, which provides family strengthening and community support activities for individuals residing in the City of San Antonio. A copy of said contract, in substantially final form, is affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

**SECTION 3.** The Finance Department is authorized to process payment to the U.S. Military Veterans Parade Association in the amount of \$5,600.00 for the cost of police services required during the Veteran's Day Parade on November 8, 2003.

**SECTION 4.** The budget in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund) in Index Code 698977 is authorized for reduction by \$5,600.00.

**SECTION 5.** Funds in the amount of \$5,600.00 are authorized to be appropriated and encumbered in Fund 11-000000 (General Fund) in Index Code 605683 entitled "Military Parade Project" and are authorized for payment to the U.S. Military Veterans Parade Association.

**SECTION 6.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance is subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 7.** This Ordinance shall be effective on February 8, 2004.
