

AN ORDINANCE **98777**

AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES SCHEDULES ESTABLISHED BY CHAPTER 19, SECTION 68 OF CITY CODE TO INCLUDE ADDITIONS TO THE OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE SCHEDULE FOR "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES INCLUDING SUNDAYS AND HOLIDAYS" AT LOOP 1604 FROM BULVERDE ROAD TO 1500 FEET EAST OF BULVERDE ROAD IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 10; AND AT I.H. 35 SOUTH FROM 1250 FEET NORTH OF BINZ-ENGLEMAN TO 2000 FEET NORTH OF PETROLEUM DRIVE IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 2; AUTHORIZING THE PERMANENT INSTALLATION OF SAID DEVICES; DECLARING THEM AS OFFICIAL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO; AND DECLARING VIOLATIONS OF SUCH DEVICES TO BE CIVIL PARKING VIOLATIONS SUBJECT TO THE ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS OF CITY CODE SECTION 19-225; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation requested additional parking restrictions be added to the schedule of traffic control devices maintained by the City Clerk's Office in accordance with City Code section 19-68; and

WHEREAS, a traffic engineering study has deemed the additions of these locations to be warranted and necessary for the public safety; **NOW THEREFORE,**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. Traffic Control Device Schedules enacted through Section 19-68(b) of the City Code of the City of San Antonio are hereby amended and the city clerk is hereby authorized to:

include in Schedule G(a): entitled "Parking Prohibited At All Times Including Sundays and Holidays" the following locations:

<u>Street</u>	<u>Extent</u>	<u>Side</u>
Loop 1604	Bulverde Road to 1500 feet	Even
Eastbound Frontage Road	East of Bulverde Road	
I.H. 35	1250 feet north of Binz-Engleman to	Both
Southbound Frontage Road	2000 feet north of Petroleum Drive	

SECTION 2. Installation or modification of traffic control signs, signals, and other applicable devices necessary to reflect the changes within this ordinance are hereby authorized.

SECTION 3. All traffic control signs, signals, and other devices listed herein are hereby declared to be official traffic control devices of the City of San Antonio. Violations of such devices relating to parking are subject to the enforcement provisions of City Code section 19-225.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk is directed to publish public notice of this Ordinance in accordance with Article 2, Section 17, of the City Charter.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective on the fifth day after publication but in no manner before February 15, 2004


