

AN ORDINANCE **98778**

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA IN CONNECTION WITH THE RACE FOR THE CURE SPONSORED BY THE SUSAN G. KOMEN FOUNDATION TO BE HELD FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 9:30 A.M. ON SATURDAY, MARCH 27, 2004.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to the Susan G. Komen Foundation to hold the "Race for the Cure" beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, March 27, 2004; and

SECTION 2. In order to hold the "Race for the Cure" on Saturday, beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, March 27, 2004, the following streets listed below are hereby authorized to be closed to vehicular traffic:

5K Run (8:00 a.m. start): Cherry from the C Lot of the Alamodome to Durango, Durango from Cherry to Main, Main from Durango to Nueva, Nueva from Main to Alamo, Alamo from Market to Montana, and Montana from Market to Lot C of the Alamodome.

1 Mile Walk (8:10 a.m. start): Cherry from the C Lot of the Alamodome to Durango, Durango from Cherry to Highway 281 Northbound (Frontage Road), Highway 281 Northbound (Frontage Road) to Montana, Montana from Highway 281 Northbound (Frontage Road) to Cherry, Cherry from Montana to the C Lot of the Alamodome.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.


SECTION 4. Susan G. Komen Foundation shall be responsible for the following: shall be responsible for all a) insurance requirements, b) obtaining the required street closure permit fee, and any other fees, and license charges, c) posting signs, barricades, and off-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic and d) cleaning up after the event is held.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on the 15th day of February, 2004.
