

AN ORDINANCE      **98812**

**RATIFYING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO ACQUIRE .36 ACRES OF PROPERTY ADJACENT TO EISENHOWER PARK IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8 FROM THE NATIONAL PARK SERVICE, THROUGH THE FEDERAL LANDS TO PARKS PROGRAM, AT NO COST TO THE CITY.**

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**WHEREAS**, the National Park Service contacted the Parks and Recreation Department to inquire whether the City would be interested in acquiring a parcel of .36 acres that is adjacent to Eisenhower Park, located at 19299 N.W. Military Highway in City Council District 8; and

**WHEREAS**, the property is adjacent to Camp Bullis and has been identified as surplus property by the General Services Administration; and

**WHEREAS**, the property must be designated as park land and is available at no cost to the City; and

**WHEREAS**, staff investigated the property and determined that it will be appropriate to use the property as access to Eisenhower Park; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to take advantage of this offer the City needed to make an application before a deadline set by the National Park service which did not allow sufficient time to present the item to City Council prior to the application; and

**WHEREAS**, staff submitted the required application and now is seeking ratification of that action from the City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**Section 1.** City staff's action of submitting an application to acquire .36 acres of property adjacent to Eisenhower Park in City Council District 8 from the National Park Service, through the Federal Lands to Parks Program, at no cost to the City is hereby ratified.

**Section 2.** This ordinance shall be effective on February 22, 2004.
