

AN ORDINANCE **98893**

**ACCEPTING THE LOW, RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED BY FIRE SUPPLY, INC. TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO FIRE DEPARTMENT WITH POSITIVE PRESSURE FANS FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$29,632.37.**

**WHEREAS**, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with positive pressure fans which will be utilized throughout the Firefighting Division; and

**WHEREAS**, the bid submitted by Casco Industries failed to meet the City specifications; and

**WHEREAS**, Fire Supply, Inc. was the low responsive bidder for a total amount of \$29,632.37; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The low, responsive bid of Fire Supply, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Fire Department with positive pressure fans for a total amount of \$29,632.37 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bid and bid tabulation sheet are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.


**SECTION 2.** It has been found and declared that the low bid of Casco Industries failed to meet the City's specifications.


**SECTION 3.** Funds will be encumbered in Fund 11-000600 (General Fund) in Index Code 275735 entitled "Tools, Apparatus and Accessories" for \$29,632.37 when a purchase order is issued and made payable to Fire Supply, Inc.


**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect March 14, 2004.
