

AN ORDINANCE **9 8 9 0 7**

ACCEPTING THE PROPOSAL OF PROFESSIONAL SERVICES INDUSTRIES (PSI) FOR CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS TESTING SERVICES FOR THE EAST AIR CARGO EXPANSION PHASE II RAMP AND PARKING AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$17,000.00; AND AMENDING THE EXISTING CONTRACT WITH PSI TO INCLUDE SAID ADDITIONAL SERVICES PURSUANT TO THE TERMS OUTLINED IN THEIR PROPOSAL; AUTHORIZING A BUDGET AMENDMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$17,000.00 AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT

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WHEREAS, the City has in its Five Year Capital Program a project for East Air Cargo Expansion Phase II Ramp and Parking at San Antonio International Airport (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 88831 passed and approved on November 19, 1998 approved the Professional Services Contract with Pape Dawson Engineers, Inc. (the "Consultant") to provide services for the expansion to the East Air Cargo Facility at San Antonio International Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Contract Documents for the Project have been completed by the Consultant, the Project was advertised on November 13, 2003, and construction bids were opened on December 17, 2003; and

WHEREAS, it is a requirement of the Federal Aviation Administration Grant Assurances, to have a construction and materials testing laboratory monitor construction and provide quality assurance; and

WHEREAS, PSI has submitted a proposal to provide construction and material testing services for a fee not to exceed \$17,000.00; and

WHEREAS, members of City staff have reviewed the scope of work and the associated fees outlined in this proposal and have determined that the fees presented are fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to accept the proposal from PSI for construction materials testing, amend the existing contract with PSI to include additional services pursuant to the terms outlined in their proposal, revise the budget, and provide for payment; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. A proposal from the firm Professional Services Industries ("PSI") to perform construction and material testing for the East Air Cargo Expansion Phase II Ramp and Parking Project at the San Antonio International Airport for an amount not to exceed \$17,000, is hereby

accepted and the existing Professional Services Contract with PSI is amended to include this construction and material testing in accordance with their proposal dated January 6, 2004. A copy of said proposal is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as Attachment 1.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$17,000.00 is hereby authorized to be transferred from Project 26-058068, Index Code 558940 and transferred to Index Code 556092 as set forth in the Budget Schedule which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as Attachment 2.

SECTION 3. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The following amount is authorized to be encumbered in and disbursed from the accounts indicated from Project No. 26-058068.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall become effective no the tenth (10th) day after the passage hereof.
