AN ORDINANCE            **9 8 9 4 9**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUE THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH UNGERBOECK SYSTEMS, INC., WHICH WAS ORIGINALLY AUTHORIZED BY ORDINANCE NO. 90078 DATED JULY 22, 1999, TO PROVIDE FOR THE PURCHASE OF EIGHT (8) ADDITIONAL CONCURRENT USER LICENSES OF THE EVENT BUSINESS MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE AND ONE YEAR OF MAINTENANCE AND SUPPORT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,995.00 FOR THE ALAMODOME; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, City Council authorized a Professional Services Agreement (“Agreement”) with Ungerboeck Systems, Inc. (“Ungerboeck”), by the passage of Ordinance No. 90078 dated July 22, 1999, to provide the Convention and Visitors Bureau (the “CVB”) and the Convention Facilities Department with industry-based software to allow simultaneous access for booking space at the Henry B. Gonzalez Convention Center, Lila Cockrell Theater, and Municipal Auditorium; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agreement was modified by the execution of the First Amendment pursuant to Ordinance No. 93169, passed and approved on January 4, 2001, to provide for the purchase of additional services; and

**WHEREAS**, currently the Alamodome is managed and booked utilizing several different systems, including a proprietary City mainframe system as well as stand alone spreadsheets, databases and electronic calendars and these systems are not compatible with the software utilized by the CVB and the Convention Facilities Department; and

**WHEREAS**, Event Business Management Software (“EBMS”) is database management software that currently provides the Convention Facilities Department and the CVB with unified customer information and with the purchase of the additional licenses provided for by this Ordinance, Alamodome staff will be able to consolidate management of the facility and events and share booking and other information with the CVB and the Convention Facilities Department; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The terms and conditions of the Second Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with Ungerboeck Systems, Inc. to provide for the purchase of eight (8) additional concurrent user licenses of the EBMS and one year of maintenance and support in the amount of \$31,995.00 for the Alamodome are hereby authorized and approved.


**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee is authorized for a sixty (60)-day period following the effective date of this Ordinance to execute the Second Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement. Said Second Amendment, as previously executed by Ungerboeck, is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment I.


**SECTION 3.** Funds in the amount of \$31,995.00 will be encumbered in Fund 29-006000 (Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund), in Index Code 582916 entitled "Computer Software" and made payable to Ungerboeck Systems, Inc.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance of the City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth day after passage hereof.
