

AN ORDINANCE

**99010**

**AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A ONE-YEAR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$150,000.00, WITH THE SAN ANTONIO SPORTS FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT THE SOLICITATION OF AMATEUR REGIONAL, NATIONAL, AND INTERNATIONAL SPORTING EVENTS AND CONVENTIONS AND MEETINGS OF SPORTS-RELATED ASSOCIATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.**

**WHEREAS**, the San Antonio Sports Foundation (“SASF”), through its members, has worked aggressively on establishing San Antonio as a premier host city for sporting events and as evidence to their success, last year the City hosted several major sporting events including the National Collegiate Athletic Association (“NCAA”) Men’s Regional Basketball Tournament, Big 12 Women’s Soccer Championship, Sports Hall of Fame, Roundball Ruckus, U.S. Anti-Doping Meeting, Western Athletic Swimming & Diving Competition, and Southern Zone Swim Meet; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2004 NCAA Men’s Final Four Basketball Championship is currently scheduled at the Alamodome in April 2004, an NCAA Men’s Basketball Regional and an NCAA Men’s Final Four Basketball Championship are committed and scheduled for 2007 and 2008, respectively, and other upcoming events include the 2004 U.S. Open Swimming Championships, Big 12 Women’s Soccer Championship in 2004, 2005 and 2006, and 2010 NCAA Women’s Final Four Basketball Championship; and

**WHEREAS**, over the past several years, the City has contracted annually with the SASF to assist in bringing sport-related events to San Antonio and to provide a service to the City that would otherwise have to be met by City staff at an additional cost and the Fiscal Year 2003-04 adopted budget allocated \$150,000.00 for the recurring program in the current fiscal year; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a one-year professional services agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.00, with the San Antonio Sports Foundation to support the solicitation of amateur regional, national, and international sporting events and conventions and meetings of sports-related associations. A copy of said Agreement, executed by the SASF, is affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.


**SECTION 2.** Funds are authorized to be encumbered in Fund 29-005000 (Miscellaneous Special Revenue-Convention & Visitors Bureau Fund) in Index Code 395681 entitled “San

Antonio Sports Foundation" for \$150,000.00 and made payable to The San Antonio Sports Foundation to support the above activities.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance of the City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10th) day after the date of passage hereof.
