

AN ORDINANCE **99011**

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A ONE-YEAR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE SAN ANTONIO SPORTS FOUNDATION, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$350,000.00, IN ORDER TO AUGMENT THE BASE PROGRAM BY SUPPORTING THE DIRECT SOLICITATION, INCLUDING HOSTING OBLIGATIONS, SITE INSPECTIONS AND BID FEES, OF AMATEUR REGIONAL, NATIONAL, AND INTERNATIONAL SPORTING EVENTS, CONVENTIONS AND MEETINGS OF SPORT-RELATED ASSOCIATIONS FOR SAN ANTONIO, WITH A FOUR (4) YEAR RENEWAL OPTION EXTENDING THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2008, SUBJECT TO FUTURE CITY COUNCIL APPROVAL, FOR A YEARLY AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$350,000.00, WHICH AMOUNT SHALL BE REDUCED COMMENSURATE WITH THE PERCENTAGE OF THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FUNDS AVAILABLE THROUGH THE OTHER EVENTS TRUST FUND ESTABLISHED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 5190.14, SECTION 5A (VERNON'S TEXAS CIVIL STATUTES) ACTUALLY REIMBURSED TO THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Sports Foundation (hereinafter "SASF"), through its members, has worked aggressively on establishing San Antonio as a premier host city for sporting events and with the SASF's assistance the City has hosted several major sporting events in recent years; and

WHEREAS, events to be held in the coming years include the 2004 National Collegiate Athletic Association ("NCAA") Men's Final Four Basketball Championship, 2007 NCAA Men's Regional Basketball Tournament, 2008 NCAA Men's Final Four Basketball Championship, 2010 NCAA Women's Final Four Basketball Championship, 2004 U.S. Open Swimming Championship and Big 12 Women's Soccer Championship in years 2004-2006, all of which are showcase events that offer the City of San Antonio the opportunity for worldwide exposure; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Fiscal Year 2002-03 adopted budget, City Council re-allocated \$350,000.00 from the Pan American Games reserve to the SASF to assist in their efforts in securing amateur international and regional competitive sporting events, conventions and meetings of sport-related associations and the \$350,000.00 allocation recommended by this Ordinance, which was approved as part of the Fiscal Year 2003-04 adopted budget, represents a

continuation of this augmented program and any funding in future years shall remain contingent upon the availability of funds; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a one-year professional services agreement with the San Antonio Sports Foundation in an amount not to exceed \$350,000.00 for hosting obligations, site inspections and bid fees, with a four (4) year renewal option extending through September 30, 2008, subject to future City Council approval, for a yearly amount during each renewal term not to exceed \$350,000.00, which amount shall be reduced commensurate with the percentage of the total amount of funds available through the Other Events Trust Fund established pursuant to Article 5190.14, Section 5A (Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes) actually reimbursed to the City. A copy of said Agreement, executed by the SASF, is affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.


SECTION 2. Funds will be encumbered in Fund 29-005 (Miscellaneous Special Revenue Hotel/Motel Tax (Convention & Visitors Bureau) Fund) in Index Code 753491 entitled "Fee's to Pros-SASF Pan AM Reallocation" for \$350,000.00 and made payable to The San Antonio Sports Foundation.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance of the City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purposes of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10th) day after the date of passage hereof.
