

AN ORDINANCE

**ACCEPTING THE SOLE SOURCE PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY V-ONE CORPORATION TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH SMARTGATE SOFTWARE LICENSES AND MAINTENANCE FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$42,803.50.**

**WHEREAS**, a proposal was submitted by V-One Corporation, a sole source supplier, to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with SmartGate software licenses and maintenance for a total of \$42,803.50.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract will provide 1,000 additional SmartGate licenses and software maintenance to expand the number of users able to utilize the virtual private network connection to secure internet connections between the South Texas High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area and other law enforcement agencies to exchange criminal intelligence data and analysis; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Local Government Code indicates that competitive bidding is not required under section 252.022(a)(7)(A) which provides for any items that are available only from a sole source of supply; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The proposal submitted by V-One Corporation to provide the City of San Antonio Police Department with SmartGate software licenses and maintenance for a total amount of \$42,803.50 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. A copy of the proposal and bid tabulation sheet is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A. The Director of the Purchasing & General Services is hereby authorized to execute any documents necessary and incident thereto.

**SECTION 2.** Funding for this ordinance in the amount of \$42,803.50 will be from Fund No. 26-028071, Index Code 767277, entitled Computer Software, and said amount will be encumbered when purchasing issues the purchase order and payment is hereby authorized to V-One Corporation.

**SECTION 3.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2004.
