

AN ORDINANCE **99017**

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR JOSEPHINE STREET IN CONNECTION WITH THE POLICE OFFICER MEMORIAL RUN SPONSORED BY THE RUN AWAY STORE TO BE HELD FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 11:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY, MAY 22, 2004.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to **Run Away Store** so that it may hold the "Police Officer Memorial Run" to be held on Saturday, May 22, 2004 beginning at 7:00.m. until 11:0 a.m.

SECTION 2. In order to hold the "Police Officer Memorial Run" on Saturday, May 2, 2004 beginning at 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m., the temporary closure of portions of the streets listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

Assembly Area: Avenue B between Josephine and Pearl Parkway
Run/Walk Route: North on Avenue B to Tuleta, (turn around)
South on Avenue B to Josephine.


SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. The **Run Away Store** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 5. The **Run Away Store** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on the 11th day of April, 2004.
