

AN ORDINANCE **99015**

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR BRACKENRIDGE PARK IN CONNECTION WITH THE MARCH OF DIMES WALK AMERICA 2004 SPONSORED BY THE MARCH OF DIMES TO BE HELD FROM 7:30 A.M. TO 10:30 A.M. ON SATURDAY, MAY 15, 2004.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to March of Dimes hold its “ March of Dimes Walk America 2004” on Saturday, May 15, 2004 beginning at 7:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m.

SECTION 2. In order to hold the “March of Dimes Walk America 2004” on Saturday, May 15, 2004 beginning at 7:30 a.m. until 10:30 a.m., the temporary closure of portions of the streets listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

Assembly Area: Zoo Parking Lot

Run/Walk Route: Starting southbound on St. Marys at the Zoo Parking Lot,
South on St. Marys to Mulberry, then
East on Mulberry to Red Oak, then
North on Red Oak to Tuleta, then
East on Tuleta to Wilderness, then
South on Wilderness to Brackenridge, then
North on Brackenridge to Parfun Way, then
North on Parfun Way to Tuleta, then
East on Tuleta to Brackenridge, then
South on Brackenridge to Parfun Way, then
East on Parfun Way to Avenue B, then
North on Avenue B to Tuleta, then
West on Tuleta to Brackenridge, and
North on Brackenridge to sidewalk leading into Park, and
Exit at Zoo (Circle), and
South on St. Marys to Zoo Parking Lot.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. The **March of Dimes** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio’s Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 5. The **March of Dimes** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out

of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on the 11th day of April, 2004.
