

AN ORDINANCE **99018**

**APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS IN AND NEAR DOWNTOWN IN CONNECTION WITH THE 13<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL COURTHOUSE TO JAILHOUSE RUN SPONSORED BY THE SAN ANTONIO BAR FOUNDATION TO BE HELD FROM 6:30 A.M. TO 10:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY, JUNE 5, 2004.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Council hereby approves the requested parade permit to the San Antonio Bar Association so that it may hold the "13<sup>th</sup> Annual Courthouse to Jailhouse Run" on Saturday, June 5, 2004 beginning at 6:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m.

**SECTION 2.** In order to hold the "13<sup>th</sup> Annual Courthouse to Jailhouse Run" on Saturday, June 5, 2004 beginning at 6:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m., the temporary closure of portions of the streets listed in the route below to vehicular traffic is hereby authorized:

**Assembly Area:** Avenue B between Josephine and Grayson  
**Run/Walk Route:** South on Avenue B to Newell (Total)  
West on Newell to Camden (Eastbound Lanes only)  
South on Camden to Baltimore (Total)  
East on Baltimore to Augusta (Total)  
South on Augusta to Convent (Total)  
West on Convent to Soledad (Total)  
North on Soledad to Savings (2 Right Lanes)  
West on Savings to Main (Total)  
South on Main to Dolorosa (2 Left Lanes)  
East on Dolorosa to Soledad (1 Left Lane)  
North on Soledad to Convent (1 Right Lane)  
East on Convent to Augusta (Total)  
North on Augusta to Baltimore (Total)  
West on Baltimore to Camden (Total)  
North on Camden to Newell (Total)  
East on Newell to Avenue B (Eastbound Lanes Only)  
North on Avenue B to Start/Finish (Total)


**SECTION 3.** The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

**SECTION 4.** The San Antonio Bar Association shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

**SECTION 5.** The San Antonio Bar Association shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall be effective on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2004.


