

AN ORDINANCE

**ACCEPTING THE LOW RESPONSIVE BID SUBMITTED BY DELL UTILIZING THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION RESOURCES (DIR) "GO DIRECT" PROGRAM TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY SERVICES DEPARTMENT WITH AN EMC FILE SERVER STORAGE CAPACITY EXPANISON FOR A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$51,314.00.**

**WHEREAS**, a bid was submitted by Dell to provide the City of San Antonio ("City") Information Technology Services Department with an EMC file server storage capacity expansion for a total amount of \$51,314.00; and

**WHEREAS**, this contract will provide hardware and software necessary to expand and improve the City's storage area network; and

**WHEREAS**, this purchase meets the requirements under the terms of the State of Texas Cooperative Purchasing Agreement adopted by the City of San Antonio by Resolution No. 91-39-53 on September 12, 1991; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The bid of Dell in the amount of \$51,314.00 to provide the City's Information Technology Services Department with software and hardware to expand the EMC file servers' storage capacity is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. A copy of the bid tabulation sheet and contract are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

**SECTION 2.** Funds in the amount of \$43,834.00 will be encumbered in Fund 74-000000 (Information Services Fund), in Index Code 557736 entitled "Computer Equipment" when a purchase order is issued and made payable to Dell.

**SECTION 3.** Funds in the amount of \$7,480.00 will be encumbered in Fund 74-000000 (Information Services Fund), in Index Code 672162 entitled "Computer Software" when a purchase order is issued and made payable to Dell.

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall take effect April 25<sup>th</sup>, 2004.
