

AN ORDINANCE **99152**

**AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT OF A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE FIRM OF 3D/INTERNATIONAL TO ADD SURVEYING SERVICES IN CONJUNCTION WITH ARCHITECTURAL AND ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE NEW TERMINAL EXPANSION PROJECT AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$186,214.60; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; REVISING THE BUDGET AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT**

**WHEREAS**, the City has in its Five Year Capital Program, a project to construct a new terminal facility at San Antonio International Airport (the "Project"); and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 97709 passed and approved on May 29, 2003, awarded a Professional Services Agreement to the firm of 3D/International (3DI) for architectural and engineering services in connection with the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the original scope of work under this Agreement specifically excluded the surveying component in order to allow 3DI, Carter Burgess (the Program Manager), and City staff to evaluate realistic surveying needs developed during the design development phase; and

**WHEREAS**, the design phase of the Project is 60% complete, an assessment of these surveying needs has been completed, and a surveying work plan has been developed; and

**WHEREAS**, 3DI has submitted a proposal for said surveying services which has been reviewed by City staff together with Carter Burgess, who together have determined that the fees presented are fair and reasonable for the work involved; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to amend the contract with 3DI to include surveying services, appropriate funds and provide for payment; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The proposal from 3D/International for surveying and subsurface utility exploration in the amount not to exceed \$186,214.60 is hereby accepted. A copy of said proposal is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as Attachment 1.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized for the next 60 days following the effective date of this Ordinance to execute an amendment to the Professional Services Contract approved by Ordinance No. 96790 with 3D/International to provide additional services in conjunction with the new terminal facility at International Airport. This amendment shall be attached as Attachment III upon execution by all parties.

**SECTION 3.** The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 4.** Funds in the amount of \$111,728.76 are authorized for appropriation in the Airport System Construction Bond Fund No. 51-005 to Project No. 51-006004, Index Code 918441, entitled "Transfer to 51-006005 (IC 129742).

**SECTION 5.** The Budget in Fund 51-006005, Index Code 129742 entitled "Transfer from 51-005004" is authorized for increase in the amount of \$111,728.76 and a transfer in this amount is authorized to be made from Project No. 51-005004 to Project No. 51-006005 as set forth in the Budget Schedule which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as Attachment II.

**SECTION 6.** The budget in Fund 51-006005, Index Code 076711 is authorized for increase in the amount of \$74,485.84 as set forth in the Budget Schedule which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as Attachment II.

**SECTION 7.** The following amounts are authorized for appropriation and encumbrance, up to the amounts indicated, from Expenditure Account Index Nos. as indicated.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day after passage hereof.


