

AN ORDINANCE **99144**

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HER DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT TWO (2) FY 2004 TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REGIONAL SOLID WASTE PASS-THROUGH GRANTS TOTALING \$246,207.50 FROM THE ALAMO AREA COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS; AND AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF ANY AMENDED ALLOCATIONS OF FY 2004 GRANT MONIES THAT MAY BECOME AVAILABLE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The City Manager or her designee is hereby authorized to accept two Texas Commission on environmental Quality (TCEQ) Regional Solid Waste Pass-Through Grants totaling \$246,207.50, from the Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG) as follows:

- \$128,907.50 – Recycling and Green Education Program Phase II. These funds will continue promotion of the City’s recycling programs including curbside collection and yard waste composting. Residents will be targeted in a variety of ways, including bilingual media and a “mobile recycling program” for use with children’s education programs.
- \$117,300.00 – Funding will be used for enhancements to the City’s brush/bulky item collection center adjacent to Camargo Park, to include design and construction of concrete ramps to facilitate citizen unloading.

**SECTION 2.** The City Manager or her designee is further authorized to accept any amended allocations of grant monies that may become available for the funding period at hand.

**SECTION 3.** The following Funds are designated for use in accounting for the two grants and the sum of \$246,207.50 is hereby appropriated to the respective Funds:

**SECTION 4.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 5.** This Ordinance shall be effective on May 16, 2004.
