ACKNOWLEDGING A CONTRACT MODIFICATION TO THE ALAMO AREA CHILD CARE DELIVERY SYSTEM (CCDS) CONTRACT WITH ALAMO WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT, INC., WHICH EXTENDS THE CONTRACT THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2005 AND WHICH AWARDS ADDITIONAL FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$32,696,357.00 FOR THE PERIOD BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2004 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2005; AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF SAID FUNDING; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A DELEGATE AGENCY CONTRACT WITH THE ALAMO AREA DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$617,614.00 TO PROVIDE CHILDCARE SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPERATION OF THE ALAMO AREA CCDS PROGRAM; AND ADOPTING A 2004-2005 CCDS PROGRAM BUDGET AND APPROVING A PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Antonio, through its Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) Division of the Department of Community Initiatives, was awarded a contract with the Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. (AWD), to serve as the operator for the Alamo CCDS Program for the period of September 1, 2003 through August 31, 2005 for the Alamo Workforce Development Area; and

**WHEREAS**, the Texas Workforce Commission through AWD endeavors to realign its contracting period to mirror the federal fiscal year beginning October 1 of each year and concluding September 30 of the subsequent year; and

**WHEREAS**, AWD intends to modify its contract with the City of San Antonio by extending the term of the contract to September 30, 2005; and

**WHEREAS**, AWD has notified the City of its intent to award additional funding to the City of San Antonio in the amount of \$32,696,357.00 for the period beginning October 1, 2004 to September 30, 2005 for provision of child care services in the Alamo Area CCDS program; and

**WHEREAS**, AWD's contract with the City permits the City to execute a delegate agency contract with other agencies for the provision of child care services; and

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to contract with the Alamo Area Development Corporation in the amount of \$617,614.00 for the provision of rural childcare services; **NOW THEREFORE**:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** A contract modification forthcoming from the Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. (AWD) in October 2004 which will extend the contract period through September 30, 2005, and which will award additional funding in the amount of \$32,696.357.00 for the Alamo Workforce Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) program for the period beginning October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005, is acknowledged. A copy of the AWD letter of intent detailing said modification is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

**SECTION 2.** Upon award, the City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives, is authorized to accept said award from the AWD in the amount of \$32,696,357.00 to operate the Alamo CCDS program for the period beginning October 1, 2004 and ending September 30, 2005.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager, or her designee, or the Director of the Department of Community Initiatives, is authorized to execute a Delegate Agency Contract with the Alamo Area Development Corporation in the amount of \$617,614.00 to provide childcare services in connection with the operation of the Alamo Area CCDS program. A copy of said contract is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment II.

**SECTION 4.** The budget for Project No. 26-039017 entitled "Child Care Delivery System Program 2004 – 2005", attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment III, is adopted.


**SECTION 5.** The personnel complement, including the transfer of current filled and vacant positions between grant activities within the project, attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment IV, is approved.

**SECTION 6.** The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, may correct the allocations to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this ordinance.

**SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall be effective on and after October 3, 2004.


