

AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR ST. PIUS X SCHOOL IN CONNECTION WITH THE ST. PIUS X REBEL WALK TO BE HELD FROM 9:00 A.M. UNTIL 11:30 A.M. ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 9, 2004, SPONSORED BY ST. PIUS X PTO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the St. Pius X PTO to hold the "St. Pius X Rebel Walk" on Saturday, October 9, 2004, from 9:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

Route

Assembling in the St. Pius X School Courtyard (7734 Robin Rest);  
South on Robin Rest to Urban Crest;  
West on Urban Crest to Vandiver;  
North on Vandiver to Rockhill;  
Disbanding in the St. Pius X School Courtyard.

SECTION 3. St. Pius X PTO shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. St. Pius X PTO shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of October, 2004.


