

AN ORDINANCE **99182**

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO IN ORDER FOR THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT TO PROVIDE HEPATITIS B IMMUNIZATION SERVICES TO APPROXIMATELY ONE HUNDRED STATE EMPLOYEES AND FOR THE CITY TO BE REIMBURSED IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,000.00.

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WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, through the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD), currently provides comprehensive public health services to protect the health of all residents within the jurisdiction of the SAMHD; and

WHEREAS, the SAMHD provides immunizations against hepatitis B, in accordance with recommendations promulgated by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention of the U. S. Public Health Service ; and

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation desires to contract with the City of San Antonio through an Interlocal Agreement for the SAMHD to provide hepatitis B immunization services to approximately one hundred (100) State employees; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary approve the execution of the Interlocal Agreement for these immunization services; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement in an amount not to exceed \$12,000.00 with the Texas Department of Transportation for the SAMHD to provide hepatitis B immunization services to approximately one hundred (100) State employees. A copy of the Interlocal Agreement, in substantially correct form, is attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 2. Fund No. 29-017000, Public Health Support Revenue Fund, is hereby designated for use in accounting for the fiscal transactions of this project.


SECTION 3. Payments received from the Texas Department of Transportation are to be deposited into the above-designated fund, Activity 36-01-01, Revenue Index 051193.


