

AN ORDINANCE **99181**

AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 98261, PASSED ON OCTOBER 2, 2003 BY AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A REIMBURSEMENT GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$40,000.00 FROM THE TRANSPORTATION SECURITY ADMINISTRATION (TSA) FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES INCURRED DUE TO INCREASED PARTICIPATION IN THE TSA EXPLOSIVES DETECTION CANINE TEAM PROGRAM AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT; REVISING THE PROGRAM BUDGET; REVISING THE PERSONNEL COMPLEMENT; AND AMENDING BUDGET ORDINANCE NO. 98181.

WHEREAS, the Aviation and Transportation Security Act was established to improve airport security; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) offers grant funding for enhanced security programs; and

WHEREAS, San Antonio International Airport desires to continue its participation in the TSA Explosives Detection Canine Team Program to respond to threats and suspected threat explosive devices which affect public safety or air carrier operations; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the acceptance of a grant when offered, by the TSA, revise the budget, and revise the personnel complement; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee is authorized to accept a grant in an amount not to exceed \$40,000.00 from the Transportation Security Administration ("TSA") to reimburse the Aviation Department for costs related to the City of San Antonio's for continued and increased participation in the TSA Explosives Detection Canine Team Program. Said program establishes eligible reimbursement of up to \$40,000.00 per team and TSA has approved funding for an additional team in San Antonio. Funding will enhance canine team utilization at the San Antonio International Airport and continue 24-hour per day, 7-day per week responses.

SECTION 2. Fund No. 26-059195, entitled "AIRPORT K-9 GRANT" is hereby designated for use in accounting for the above grant, and the sum of \$40,000.00 is hereby appropriated in said fund as set out in the detailed budget affixed hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment I.

SECTION 3: Ordinance No. 98261, passed and approved on October 2, 2003 is amended to increase the number of canine teams at the San Antonio International Airport from three (3) to four (4) teams.

SECTION 4: Ordinance No. 98181, passed and approved on September 18, 2003 is amended to revise the Aviation Department personnel complement and increase the authorized personnel by one (1) person.

SECTION 5. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to the concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of the Ordinance.

SECTION 6. The ordinance shall be effective on the tenth day after passage.
