

AN ORDINANCE **99178**

AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A GRANT APPLICATION FOR STATE/FEDERAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED THROUGH THE TEXAS STATE LIBRARY AND ARCHIVES COMMISSION IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$716,838.00, WHICH, IF AWARDED, WILL BE USED FOR PUBLIC LIBRARY DEVELOPMENT, INCLUDING GRANT ADMINISTRATION, CONSULTING, NETWORKED RESOURCES, SERVICES TO DISADVANTAGED POPULATIONS, CONTINUING EDUCATION, COLLECTION DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS AND THE PURCHASE OF LIBRARY MATERIALS IN THE ALAMO AREA LIBRARY SYSTEM FOR THE GRANT PERIOD SEPTEMBER 1, 2004 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2005.

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio is a Major Resource Center for the Alamo Area Library System providing services to Bexar county and 20 other contiguous counties; and

WHEREAS, since 1972, the City has provided this service and has accepted federal grant funds through the Texas State Library and Archives in support of this service; and

WHEREAS, the City must annually apply to receive the grant funds which make this service possible and it is now necessary for the City Council to authorize the submission of a grant application to the Texas State Library and Archives; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is hereby authorized to make application for State/Federal assistance through the Texas State Library and Archives Commission in the amount of \$716,838.00 for use in the San Antonio Public Library's role as the Major Resource Center for the Alamo Area Library System.

Section 2. Funding will be accomplished in subsequent ordinance, when funds are approved.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective on.
