

ORDINANCE 99648

APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR MISSION SAN JOSE IN CONNECTION WITH THE MISSION HERITAGE 5K TO BE HELD ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2004 FROM 6:30 A.M. UNTIL 10:00 A.M., SPONSORED BY MISSION SAN JOSE

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BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the Mission San Jose to hold the Mission Heritage 5K on Sunday, September 19, 2004 from 6:30 a.m. until 10:00 a.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

Route:

Assembling at Mission San Jose,
South on San Jose to Napier,
South on Napier to Padre,
South on Padre to Mission Parkway,
South on Mission Parkway to Water Crossover,
Returning on the same route Northbound.

SECTION 3. The Mission San Jose shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. The Mission San Jose shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on the 12th day of September, 2004.
