

AN ORDINANCE **99314**

AMENDING THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT AND AUTHORIZING ADDITIONAL FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500.00 FROM 1994-1999 GENERAL OBLIGATION DRAINAGE IMPROVEMENT BOND FUNDS PAYABLE TO DON DURDEN, INC. D/B/A CIVIL ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS (CEC) FOR ADDITIONAL SURVEYING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE GOLIAD ROAD – PECAN VALLEY TO MILITARY, PHASE 1 PROJECT, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 3; REVISING THE PROJECT; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The professional services contract between the City of San Antonio and Don Durden, Inc. dba Civil Engineering Consultants originally approved by Ordinance No. 81854 dated March 16, 1995, is hereby amended. The amount of \$2,500.00 for additional surveying services in connection with the Goliad Road – Pecan Valley to Military, Phase I Project is hereby authorized.

SECTION 2. The following financial adjustments are hereby authorized to effect this Ordinance:

The amount of \$2,500.00 is appropriated in Fund No. 45-468010, 1994 Drainage Bonds Sold In 1998A, in Index Code 935759, entitled “Trf To 45-546010 Goliad-Pecan Valley”. The amount of \$2,500.00 is authorized to be transferred from fund 45-468010 to fund 45-546010.

The budget in fund 45-546000, 1985 Drainage & Flood Control Sold 1994, shall be revised by increasing Index Code 116582, entitled “Trf Fr 45-468010(45-546010)Goliad-Pec”, by the amount of \$2,500.00.

The amount of \$2,500.00 is appropriated in fund 45-546010, 1985 Drainage & Flood Control Sold 1994, in Index Code 472050, entitled “Engineering Contract”, and is authorized to be encumbered and made payable to **Don Durden, Inc., dba Civil Engineering Consultants (CEC)**, for surveying services in connection with the Goliad Road – Pecan Valley to Military, Phase I project.



The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.
