

AN ORDINANCE

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF CASH GRANTS AND DONATIONS IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$6,700.00 (\$1,500.00 FROM AVENTIS PASTEUR, \$500.00 FROM MERCK & CO., INC., \$4,500.00 FROM GLAXOSMITHKLINE PHARMACEUTICALS, AND A \$200.00 CASH DONATION FROM AN ANONYMOUS DONOR) TO SUPPORT THE SPECIAL IMMUNIZATIONS PROMOTIONS PROJECT OF THE SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT; AND REVISING THE PROGRAM BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) operates an immunization program that provides routine childhood, adult and foreign travel vaccines to local residents through a host of community partners; and

WHEREAS, this immunization program is augmented through media campaigns, public service announcements, provider meetings and similar social marketing efforts that promote immunizations in the community and keep medical providers apprised of changes in vaccine availability and administration procedures; and

WHEREAS, vaccine manufacturers, media outlets, medical providers, and other businesses are willing to support such efforts as a service to the community; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 92955, passed and approved on November 30, 2000, authorized the establishment of the Special Immunizations Promotions Project Fund to account for such grants and donations through December 31, 2005; and

WHEREAS, since this Fund was established, \$81,190.00 has been provided by various businesses and other entities to support this effort; and

WHEREAS, several additional grants and donations have been received and it is now necessary to accept these funds and revise the project budget; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, is hereby authorized to accept cumulative donations totaling \$6,700.00 (\$1,500.00 from Aventis Pasteur, \$500.00 from Merck & Co., Inc., \$4,500.00 from GlaxoSmithKline Pharmaceuticals, and a \$200.00 cash donation from an anonymous donor) in support of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District's Special Immunizations Promotion Project for the period ending December 31, 2005.


SECTION 2. The account entitled "Special Immunizations Promotion Project," Fund 26-012185, Activity 36-07-72, has previously been designated for use in accounting for this project.


SECTION 3. The additional cumulative sum of \$6,700.00 is hereby appropriated in the above-designated fund for the activity outlined in Attachment I. The revision to the budget set out in Attachment I is hereby approved and adopted for entry on the City books.


