AN ORDINANCE **99150**

ACCEPTING THE BEST VALUE BID SUBMITTED BY OAK HILL TECHNOLOGY, INC. TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO METROPOLITAN HEALTH DISTRICT WITH DATA ENTRY SERVICES FOR AN ESTIMATED ANNUAL COST OF \$60,000.00.

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WHEREAS, bids were submitted to provide the City of San Antonio Metropolitan Health District with data entry services for the purpose of entering immunization records into the San Antonio Immunization Registry System (SAIRS); and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of this contract is \$60,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio ("City") has determined that the bid of Oak Hill Technology, Inc. will provide the best value to meet the City's needs for this contract; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The best value bid submitted by Oak Hill Technology, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Metropolitan Health District with data entry services for the purpose of entering immunization records into the SAIRS for an estimated cost of \$60,000.00.00 is hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the deposit by the successful bidder of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bid and bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. Funding for this Ordinance in the amount of \$60,000.00 will be from the Immunization Project 2004, Fund No. 26-022100, Index Code 698456. This amount will be encumbered when a purchase order is issued, and payment is hereby authorized to be made to Oak Hill Technology, Inc.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific Index Codes and Fund Numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect on May 16th, 2004.
