

AN ORDINANCE      **99463**

**APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR HEMISFAIR PARK IN CONNECTION WITH THE MS WALK SPONSORED BY THE MULTIPLE SCLEROSIS SOCIETY TO BE HELD FROM 7:00 A.M. TO 11:00 A.M. ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 2004.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The parade permit requested by the **Multiple Sclerosis Society** to hold the MS Walk on Saturday, September 11, 2004 from 7:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

**SECTION 2.** The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

**Route:**

Assembling at Maverick Plaza,  
North on Alamo to Houston  
West on Houston to Navarro  
North on Navarro to St. Mary's  
South on St. Mary's to Houston  
West on Houston to Santa Rosa  
South on Santa Rosa to the Market Square entrance  
West through Market Square to San Saba  
South on San Saba to Dolorosa  
East on Dolorosa to Market  
East on Market to Navarro  
North on Navarro to Crockett  
East on Crockett to Presa  
South on Presa to Market  
East on Market to Alamo  
South on Alamo,  
Disbanding at Maverick Plaza

**SECTION 3.** The **Multiple Sclerosis Society** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

**SECTION 4.** The **Multiple Sclerosis Society** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be effective on the 1st day of August, 2004.
