

AN ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS IN CONNECTION WITH THE AGA 23RD ANNUAL GUADALUPE STREET PARADE SPONSORED BY THE AVENIDA GUADALUPE ASSOCIATION, INC. TO BE HELD FROM 9:00 A.M. TO 2:00 P.M. ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2004

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by the **Avenida Guadalupe Association** to hold the **AGA 23rd Annual Guadalupe Street Parade** on Saturday, September 4, 2004 from 9:00 a.m. until 2:00 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

Forming area:

Guadalupe between Brazos and Colorado
Brazos between Durango and Guadalupe
San Fernando between Trinity and Brazos
El Paso between Trinity and Brazos

Route:

Assembling on Brazos at Trinity
West on Guadalupe to Trinity
North on Trinity to Commerce
West on Commerce to Zarzamora
South on Zarzamora to El Paso

Disbanding Area:

Zarzamora between Durango and Guadalupe
Elmendorf between Durango and El Paso
El Paso between Hamilton and Zarzamora
San Luis between Elmendorf and Zarzamora
Aztec between Elmendorf and Zarzamora

SECTION 3. **Avenida Guadalupe Association** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. Avenida Guadalupe Association shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on the 1st day of August, 2004.
