

AN ORDINANCE

**AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF \$160,000.00 AS FULL  
AND FINAL SETTLEMENT IN THE LAWSUIT STYLED  
NIKI C. HUNT V. JESSE PATINO, JR. AND THE CITY  
OF SAN ANTONIO..**

**WHEREAS**, Niki C. Hunt brought suit against former City employee Jesse Patino, Jr. and the City of San Antonio for injuries allegedly sustained as a result of a motor vehicle accident on February 11, 2002 involving a City vehicle; and

**WHEREAS**, the Plaintiff has agreed to accept a settlement of \$160,000.00, and the City Council has been briefed on legal issues relating to this suit and proposed settlement in an executive session; and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed settlement is reasonable and settlement of the lawsuit filed by Ms. Hunt without any admission of liability is in the best interest of the City; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Payment in the amount of \$160,000.00 is hereby authorized in full and final settlement from 75-001000, Insurance Reserve Fund, Index Code 690529, entitled Cambridge Claims, for the full and final settlement of the case styled Niki C. Hunt vs. Jesse Patino, Jr. and the City of San Antonio, Cause No. 2003-CI-13216 in the 45<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court of Bexar County, Texas. Payment shall be made to such persons and under such circumstances as may be directed by the City Attorney.

**SECTION 2.** The financial allocations in this Ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance, City of San Antonio. The Director may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage by eight affirmative votes.




