

AN ORDINANCE 99733

**AMENDING AND ELIMINATING VARIOUS FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT LICENSING AND TREASURY SERVICES, AND AMENDING THE CORRESPONDING SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES**

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**WHEREAS**, it is the policy of the City of San Antonio to assess fees to help offset the cost of licensing and regulating the affected businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the Fiscal Year 2004/2005 City Budget development process there has been identified the need to adjust the fee charged the maker of any check payable to the City of San Antonio that is returned unpaid by the maker's bank; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the Fiscal Year 2004/2005 City Budget development process there has been identified the need to adjust the fee charged for the Foot Peddler's License, the Truck Peddler's License, and the Canvasser's License; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition, as part of the Fiscal Year 2004/2005 City Budget development process there has been identified the need to eliminate the Itinerant Vendor License and the Sidewalk Photographer License; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to amend the City Code of the City of San Antonio to reflect these amendments; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** Chapter 2, Article I. (entitled IN GENERAL), Section 2-5 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended by adding the language that is underlined (added) and deleting the language that is stricken (~~deleted~~) to the existing text of said section as follows:

“A fee of ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)~~ thirty dollars (\$30.00) shall be charged the maker of any check payable to the City of San Antonio that is returned unpaid by the maker's bank. “

**SECTION 2.** Chapter 16, Article IX. (entitled PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, CANVASSERS; SOLICITORS), Section 16-232(a) of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended by adding the language that is underlined (added) and deleting the language that is stricken (~~deleted~~) to the existing text of said section as follows:

“(a) The license fee for a foot peddler's license shall be ~~twenty dollars (\$20.00) for a period expiring one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of issue or sixty dollars (\$60.00)~~ one hundred twenty dollars (\$120.00) for a license expiring one (1) year from the date of issue. The fee for a license for a peddler utilizing a truck, cart, or other vehicle in his/her business shall be ~~thirty dollars (\$30.00) for a period expiring one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of issue or ninety dollars (\$90.00)~~ one hundred eighty dollars (\$180.00) for a license expiring one (1) year from the date of issue. The fee for a canvasser's license shall be ~~ten dollars (\$10.00) for a period expiring one hundred twenty (120) days from the date of issue or thirty dollars (\$30.00)~~ sixty dollars (\$60.00) for a license expiring one (1) year from the date of issue.”

**SECTION 3.** All other provisions of Chapter 16, Article IX. of the City Code, entitled “PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, CANVASSERS; SOLICITORS,” shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

**SECTION 4.** Chapter 16, Article VI. (entitled ITINERANT VENDORS), Sections 16-161 through 16-173 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is deleted in its entirety. Those sections of Ordinance Nos. 40872, 71133, and 90492 codified in sections 16-161 through 16-173 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio are hereby repealed. Chapter 16, Article VI, Sections 16-161 through 16-173 shall be reserved.

**SECTION 5.** Chapter 16, Article I. (entitled IN GENERAL), Section 16-2 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby deleted in its entirety. Those sections of Ordinance No. 63230 codified in section 16-2 of the San Antonio City Code are hereby repealed. Chapter 16, Article I., Section 16-2 shall be reserved.


**SECTION 6.** All other provisions of Chapter 16, Article I. of the City Code, entitled “IN GENERAL,” shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.


**SECTION 7.** This ordinance shall be effective on October 1, 2004.
