

AN ORDINANCE 99737

ESTABLISHING AND AMENDING VARIOUS FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THE PROVISION OF LIBRARY MATERIALS AND SERVICES THROUGH THE LIBRARY DEPARTMENT, AND AMENDING THE CORRESPONDING SECTIONS OF THE CITY CODE TO REFLECT SUCH CHANGES.

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of San Antonio to assess fees to help offset the cost of operating City facilities and services; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the FY 2004/2005 City budget development process there has been identified the need to add new fees and to increase selected current fees in the Library Department; and

WHEREAS, it is now necessary to amend the City Code of the City of San Antonio to reflect these changes; **NOW THEREFORE**:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

Section 1. Section 2-11 of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is renamed "Library Department Fees."

Section 2. Section 2-11 (e) of the City Code of the City of San Antonio shall be amended to conform to the following:

- (1) The maximum library fines per item for Adult books (including paperbacks), compact discs, recordings and audiocassettes shall be \$10.00
- (2) The maximum library fines per item for Juvenile books (including paperbacks), recordings, audiocassettes, filmstrips and young adult books and paperbacks shall be \$6.00
- (3) DVD's are included as part of the category videocassettes
- (4) The daily overdue fine for videocassettes and DVD's shall be \$2.00

Section 3. Section 2-11 (k) of the City Code of the City of San Antonio shall be amended to increase the fee for the following item in the following amount:

- (5) \$0.25 per page for database printing generated through the use of the Library's public computers


Section 4. Section 2-11 is amended to add a subsection (n) which shall read as follows:

- (n) The library department is authorized to charge a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) per class for the provision of computer classes at the Central Library and branch libraries.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective on and after October 1, 2004.
