

AN ORDINANCE

**APPROVING A PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR MACARTHUR HIGH SCHOOL IN CONNECTION WITH THE SPIRIT PARADE TO BE HELD FROM 5:30 P.M. UNTIL 7:00 P.M. ON WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 29, 2004, SPONSORED BY MACARTHUR HIGH SCHOOL.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The parade permit requested by **MacArthur High School** to hold the “**Spirit Parade**” on Wednesday, September 29, 2004 from 5:30 p.m. until 7:00 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

**SECTION 2.** The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

**Route**

Assembling at MacArthur Parking Lot located at 2923 Bitters,  
West on Bitters to Mayfair,  
North on Mayfair to Severn,  
West on Severn to Wroxton,  
North on Wroxton to Asteroid,  
East on Asteroid to Mayfair,  
South on Mayfair to Bitters,  
East on Bitters to 2923 Bitters,  
Disbanding in MacArthur Parking Lot.


**SECTION 3.** **MacArthur High School** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio’s Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.


**SECTION 4.** **MacArthur High School** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.
