AN ORDINANCE 99829

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,604,992.00 FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY THROUGH THE OFFICE OF DOMESTIC PREPAREDNESS, WHICH WILL BE USED TO ASSIST THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WITH HOMELAND SECURITY READINESS OVER THE NEXT THREE TO FIVE YEARS THROUGH PLANNING, TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT AS OUTLINED IN THE SAN ANTONIO URBAN AREA STRATEGY PLAN, FOR THE GRANT PERIOD DECEMBER 1, 2003, TO NOVEMBER 30, 2005.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) has grant funds available that may be used for homeland security readiness over the next three to five years; and

WHEREAS, the DHS has offered the City of San Antonio grant funds in the amount of \$3,604,992.00; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used for planning, training, and the purchase of equipment as outlined in the San Antonio Urban Area Strategy Plan for the grant period of December 1, 2003, through November 30, 2005; and

WHEREAS, no matching funds are required; and

WHEREAS, maintenance of any equipment purchased will be the responsibility of the City beginning in FY 2006; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is hereby authorized to accept grant funds in the amount of \$3,604,992.00 from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security that will be used for homeland security readiness over the next three to five years in accordance with the San Antonio Urban Area Strategy Plan during the

grant period of December 1, 2003, through November 30, 2005. The grant document will be maintained by the San Antonio Fire Department.

SECTION 2. Fund number 26-056057 (URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE 2003-05) is hereby designated for use in accounting to record transactions for the above-designated homeland security readiness project. The sum of \$3,604,992.00 is appropriated in the aforementioned fund as set out in the detailed budget attached hereto as Attachment I.

SECTION 3. The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance. The Director of Finance may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocations to specific fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purposes of this ordinance.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect ten days from the date of passage.
