

AN ORDINANCE 99804

**AUTHORIZING THE BUDGET ADJUSTMENT TO THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION (FAA) GRANT NO. 03-48-0192-41 FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF TAXIWAY D, THE AIRFIELD GUIDANCE SIGN UPGRADE AND THE REMAIN OVERNIGHT APRON PROJECTS, ALL AT SAN ANTONIO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT BY REDUCING THE TAXIWAY D RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT GRANT FUNDS BY THE AMOUNT OF \$33,017.00, INCREASING THE AIRFIELD GUIDANCE SIGN UPGRADE PROJECT GRANT FUNDS BY THE AMOUNT OF \$4,323.00 AND INCREASING THE REMAIN OVER NIGHT APRON PROJECT GRANT FUNDS BY THE AMOUNT OF \$28,694.00; APPROPRIATING THE AMOUNT OF \$4,494.53 FOR THE TAXIWAY D RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT MATCHING FUNDS; AND REVISING THE BUDGETS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of San Antonio is currently a party to a Franchise Agreement (the "Franchise") with Time Warner Cable (TWC) that was first authorized pursuant to City Ordinance No. 49433, and became effective on November 7, 1978; and

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 94466 passed and approved on August 30, 2001, accepted a Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) grant in the amount of \$7,150,144.00 for the Taxiway D Reconstruction, the Airfield Guidance Sign Upgrade and the Remain Over Night Apron Projects all at San Antonio International Airport (the "Projects"); and

**WHEREAS**, when the FAA awards grants for multiple projects, it allows the airport sponsor to allocate funds among the named projects as necessary to fully utilize the grant funds; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial budgets for the Projects were established based on estimates of costs; and

**WHEREAS**, both the Taxiway D Reconstruction and the Airfield Guidance Sign Upgrade Projects have been completed resulting in a grant funding surplus of \$33,017.01 and grant funding deficit of \$4,323.00 respectively; and

**WHEREAS**, the Remain Over Night Apron Project is under design and needs the remaining excess grant funds of \$28,694.00 from the Taxiway D Reconstruction Project; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to properly fund items not eligible for FAA grant participation, it is necessary to appropriate the amount of \$4,494.53 from the Airport Improvement and Contingency Fund No. 51-013; and

**WHEREAS**, it is now necessary to authorize the transfer of grant funds from the Taxiway D Reconstruction Project to the Airfield Guidance Sign Upgrade and the Remain Over Night Apron Projects; **NOW THEREFORE:**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The budget for Reconstruction of Taxiway D at San Antonio International Airport Project No. 26-058065 is authorized to be amended by reducing the FAA Grant Funds in Index No. 103267 by the amount of \$33,017.00.

**SECTION 2.** The amount of \$4,494.53 is appropriated in the Airport System Improvement and Contingency Fund No. 51-013 to the Reconstruction of Taxiway D at San Antonio International Airport Project No. 26-058065, Index No. 103267. A copy of the revised budget for the Reconstruction of Taxiway D is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as Attachment 1.

**SECTION 3.** The budget for the Airfield Guidance Sign Upgrade Project No. 26-058072 is authorized to be amended by increasing the FAA Grant Funds in Index No. 029355 by the amount of \$4,323.00.

**SECTION 4.** The budget for the Airfield Guidance Sign Upgrade Project No. 26-058072 is authorized to be amended by decreasing the City funds in Index No. 912956 by the amount of \$4,323.00. A copy of the revised budget for the Airfield Guidance Sign Upgrade Project is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as Attachment 2.

**SECTION 5.** The budget for the Remain Over Night Apron Project No. 26-058073 is authorized to be amended by increasing the FAA Grant Funds in Index No. 030171 by the amount of \$28,694.00.

**SECTION 6.** The budget for the Remain Over Night Apron Project No. 26-058073 is authorized to be amended by increasing the Unallocated Appropriations in Index No. 383703 by the amount of \$28,694.00. A copy of the revised budget for the Remain Over Night Apron Project is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference for all purposes as Attachment 3.

**SECTION 7.** The financial allocations in this ordinance are subject to approval by the Director of Finance for the City of San Antonio. The Director of Finance, may, subject to concurrence by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, correct allocation to specific index codes and fund numbers as necessary to carry out the purpose of this Ordinance.


**SECTION 8.** This Ordinance shall be effective on and after the tenth (10<sup>th</sup>) day after passage hereof.


