

AN ORDINANCE ' 99846

**APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR SUNSET STATION IN CONNECTION WITH THE VITAL ALLIANCE 5K TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2004 FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 11:00 A.M. SPONSORED BY VITAL ALLIANCE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The parade permit requested by Vital Alliance to hold the "Vital Alliance 5K" on Saturday, October 16, 2004 from 8:00 a.m. until 11:00 a.m., is hereby approved. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

**SECTION 2.** The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

**Assembly Area:** Sunset Station;  
**Route:** South on Hoefgen to Alamo Dome  
Once around the Alamo Dome to the walkway  
North on Walkway to Bowie Street crosswalk (across from Convention Center)  
South on Bowie to entrance to Institute of Texas Culture (pedestrian cross walk only vehicles will be stopped, runners on sidewalk to Institute grounds)  
West on Institute property to Alamo  
North on Alamo to Market (sidewalk)  
East on Market to Bowie (sidewalk)  
South on Alamo Dome walkway back to the Dome.

**SECTION 3.** The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

**SECTION 4.** Vital Alliance shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,
- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area after the event is held.

**SECTION 5.** Vital Alliance shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


**SECTION 6.** This ordinance shall be effective on the 17th day of October, 2004.
