

AN ORDINANCE ' 99864

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR MARY HULL ELEMENTARY (7320 REMUDA) IN CONNECTION WITH THE SAY NO TO DRUGS WALK - RED RIBBON WEEK TO BE HELD ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 29, 2004 FROM 12:30 P.M. UNTIL 2:30 P.M. SPONSORED BY MARY HULL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by Mary Hull Elementary School to hold the "Say No To Drugs Walk - Red Ribbon Week" on Friday, October 29, 2004 from 12:30 p.m. until 2:30 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

Assembly Area: 7320 Remuda (Parking Lot)
Route: South on Westedge to Westlawn,
East on Westlawn to Westmar,
North on Westmar to Westport.
West on Westport to Westedge
North on Westedge to Remuda,
East on Remuda to Westmar
South on Westmar to Westlawn,
West on Westlawn to Westedge
North on Westedge to Remuda and disband at Mary Hull Elementary

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to further implement this ordinance by taking any additional actions deemed necessary to protect the public.

SECTION 4. Mary Hull Elementary School shall be responsible for the following:

- a) all insurance requirements,
- b) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges,
- c) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police

- Departments, to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and
- d) cleaning the area after the event is held.


SECTION 5. Mary Hull Elementary School shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages, injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

SECTION 6. This ordinance shall be effective on the 24th day of October, 2004.
