

AN ORDINANCE

ACCEPTING THE BIDS OF VARIOUS COMPANIES TO PROVIDE THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO WITH THE VARIOUS TYPES OF COMMODITIES AND SERVICES ON AN ANNUAL CONTRACT BASIS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2004-2005 FOR AN ESTIMATED COMBINED ANNUAL COST OF \$1,240,359.00 TO INCLUDE CONTRACTS FOR ASPHALTS, OIL AND EMULSIONS AND EMERGENCY VEHICLE TIRES.

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WHEREAS, the City is able to obtain significant savings by purchasing various materials and services on an annual contract basis; and

WHEREAS, this group of contracts represents a portion of approximately two hundred and fifty (250) annual contracts that will be brought before City Council throughout the remainder of the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, these bids are from various companies to furnish the City with asphalts, oil and emulsions and emergency vehicle tires; and

WHEREAS, Section I of the attachment consists of four (4) competitive bids in which awards are recommended to the lowest bidders; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that approximately \$20,000,000.00 will be spent on annual contracts during the 2004-2005 fiscal year and such expenditures will be in accordance with the 2004-2005 budget approved by City Council; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The bids of various companies to furnish the City with asphalts, oil and emulsions and emergency vehicle tires on an annual contract basis, are hereby accepted, subject to and contingent upon the deposit of all required bonds, performance deposits and insurance certificates. All other bids will be considered rejected upon the successful bidder's completion of all conditions precedent to award or the expiration of sixty days from the effective date hereof, whichever occurs first. The bids and bid tabulation sheets are attached hereto and incorporated herein for all purposes as Attachment A.

SECTION 2. This ordinance contains four (4) contract awards for a total of approximately \$1,240,359.00. Copies of all bid packets are available for review in the Purchasing Department of the City of San Antonio and a list of the successful bidders is available for review in the City Clerk's Office.

SECTION 3. Funding will not be expended by this ordinance. All expenditures will be in accordance with the 2004-2005 budget approved by City Council.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect October 24th, 2004.
