**APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR LITTLE FLOWER CHURCH (905 KENTUCKY) IN CONNECTION WITH THE LITTLE FLOWER SCHOOL RUN FOR THE ROSES SPONSORED BY LITTLE FLOWER CHURCH TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 6, 2004 FROM 8:00 A.M. UNTIL 11:30 A.M.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:**

**SECTION 1.** The parade permit requested by **Little Flower School** to hold the “Run for the Roses” on Friday, November 6, 2004 from 8:00 a.m. until 11:30 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

**SECTION 2.** The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

**Route**

Assembling at Little Flower School, 905 Kentucky,  
Exit Parking Lot of Little Flower Church,  
Northbound on Elmendorf to Texas,  
Westbound on Texas to Alexander,  
Northbound on Alexander to Woodlawn Lake Running track,  
Circle Lake and Return,  
Southbound on Alexander to Texas,  
Eastbound on Texas to Elmendorf,  
Southbound on Elmendorf to Kentucky,  
Eastbound on Kentucky to Little Flower Church Parking Lot (Disbanding Area).

**SECTION 3.** **Little Flower School** shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio’s Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

**SECTION 4.** **Little Flower School** shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages,

injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.

**SECTION 5.** This ordinance shall be effective on October 31, 2004.
