

AN ORDINANCE § 99913

APPROVING THE PARADE PERMIT AND AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PORTIONS OF CERTAIN STREETS NEAR MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL (1227 MEMORIAL STREET) IN CONNECTION WITH THE HOMECOMING PARADE SPONSORED BY MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL TO BE HELD ON FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2004 FROM 7:45 A.M. UNTIL 9:30 A.M.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:

SECTION 1. The parade permit requested by **Memorial High School** to hold the "Homecoming Parade" on Friday, November 5, 2004 from 7:45 a.m. until 9:30 p.m., is hereby granted. The City finds that granting this request will promote the health, safety, and welfare of the participants and the public in the vicinity.

SECTION 2. The temporary closure to vehicular traffic, of portions of the streets listed in the route below which are in the City of San Antonio, is hereby authorized during the event:

Route

Assembling at the West Wing of Memorial High School on Southwest 34th Street,
South on 34th Street to Pickford,
East on Pickford to Memorial Street,
North on Memorial Street to Cornelia,
West on Cornelia to 34th Street,
South on 34th Street to the West Wing of Memorial High School (Disbanding Area).

SECTION 3. Memorial High School shall be responsible for the following: 1) all insurance requirements, 2) paying the required street closure permit fee and any other fees and license charges, 3) posting signs, barricades and the use of any off duty or on-duty police officers, as may be required by the City of San Antonio's Public Works and/or Police Departments, 4) to evidence the street closure and to provide for the safety of patrons and the rerouting of traffic, and 5) cleaning the area up after the event is held.

SECTION 4. Memorial High School shall assume all risks inherent in this event and shall indemnify and hold harmless the City of San Antonio from any and all costs, damages,

injuries, or losses attendant to, or in any way growing out of this special use of the public street right-of-ways.


SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be effective on October 31, 2004.
